



Wyoming, Kansas horsemen join National HBPA

(Video) National HBPA: This is who we are. This is what we stand for.

HOT SPRINGS, Ark. (Saturday, March 7, 2026) — Wyoming and Kansas thoroughbred horsemen are now part of the National HBPA, giving America's largest racehorse owners' and trainers' organization its 30th and 31st affiliates.

The Wyoming HBPA and Kansas HBPA were unanimously approved for full membership at Saturday's board meeting of the National Horsemen's Benevolent & Protective Association, which concluded the annual conference at Oaklawn Park. Of the 31 HBPA affiliates, 26 are in the United States along with five in the Canadian provinces.

DAA will ask approval from the NMRC of their 2026 Stakes Schedule, purse structure, condition book #1 and condition book official. Stall applications need to be returned by 3/18/2026. There will be a 50-stall limit on trainers. Exact dates of DAA meet will be available soon along with the above items once they are approved.



Ruidoso Meet will be run at Albuquerque this summer. Ruidoso will ask approval from the NMRC of their 2026 Stakes Schedule, purse structure, condition book #1 and condition book official. TBs will run, several of the past Stakes have been added. Exact dates of Ruidoso meet will be available soon.



Special post time of 11 am on March 13th & 14th. We have 14 West Texas Futurity Trials on March 13th & 13 NM Spring Futurity Trials on March 14th. Sunland expanded their daily race schedule to a minimum of 10 races per day. Purses increased (see page 3).

Sunland Park Racetrack and Casino announces purse increases and expanded race schedule

Sunland Park Racetrack and Casino officials announced today a significant boost to its remaining racing season, including a \$310,000 increase in stakes purses and an expanded daily race schedule beginning Friday, March 6.

Driven by stronger-than-predicted casino performance and available purse funds, the track will now card a minimum of 10 races per day through the conclusion of the current meet.

The purse increases impact several of the meet's most prestigious events. Both the New Mexico Breeders' Oaks and the New Mexico Breeders' Derby will see jumps from \$130,000 to \$175,000. Additionally, the Casa Ford Sunland Stakes—a key fixture on the local calendar—has been raised to \$250,000.

The schedule of increases includes:

Casa Ford Sunland Stakes: Increased to \$250,000 (from \$200,000)

Mine That Bird Derby: Increased to \$175,000 (from \$125,000)

NM Breeders' Oaks & Derby: Increased to \$175,000 (from \$130,000)

NM State University Stakes: Increased to \$100,000 (from \$80,000)

NM Spring Fling & West Texas Juvenile (Consolations): Increased to \$100,000 (from \$50,000)

The expanded 10-race minimum schedule ensures more opportunities for owners and trainers to compete for the enriched prize money during the final month of the season.
